## **SPEAKER: Professor Dr. CHRISTOPHER KEE**

**Professor Christopher Kee** is an Australian lawyer and academic whose substantive legal expertise ranges from international commercial law (broadly defined) through to legal education. Christopher also has extensive experience across a range of university management and governance roles. Separately from his university work, Christopher sits as an international arbitrator, and is one of the three Directors of the prestigious Willem C. Vis International Commercial Arbitration Moot.

Prior to joining Flinders, Christopher spent seven years at the University of Aberdeen where he held leadership positions at School, Faculty and University levels. Before Aberdeen, he was a co-author and senior researcher on the Global Sales Law Project at the University of Basel, Switzerland. He has held appointments as an Honorary Fellow of Deakin Law School, Australia, and as an Adjunct Professor at the City University of Hong Kong.

Christopher has published widely, particularly in the field of arbitration, and has been invited to lecture in numerous countries around the world. As a representative of APRAG (Asia Pacific Regional Arbitration Group), he participated in the UNCITRAL Arbitration Rules revision process from 2007 to their completion in 2010. Christopher previously served on the ACICA (Australian Centre for International Commercial Arbitration) Rules Drafting committee, and is a past Co-Chair of AFIA (Asia Pacific Forum for International Arbitration).

**Fernanda Nemr** is a Senior Associate in the Litigation and Arbitration practice of Muriel Advogados in São Paulo. She holds a bachelor's degree from the University of São Paulo and is specialized in Energy Law by the Brazilian Institute of Energy Law. She was a Visiting Foreign Lawyer at the International Arbitration practice at WilmerHale in London.

Fernanda participated in the Vis Moot in 2019 and 2020 and was actively involved as a coach until 2023. She also participated in other domestic and international moot court competitions and is one of the co-founders of the Brazilian Arbitration and Technology Moot (CoDiTech Moot), as well as a member of the organization committee of the Brazilian Arbitration Moot. Fernanda was Chair of Events (Vienna) for the MAA from 2023 to 2025 and was previously a Regional Representative.
