WELCOME FROM THE VIS EAST MOOT



Welcome to the 23rd edition of the Vis East Moot! This year we had another record-breaking year with 176 registered teams from five continents, our largest cohort since 2003, when the Vis East began with 14 teams. Welcome to all the teams, whether you're "regulars" or brand new!



Over decades, the Vis Moot in Vienna and Vis East in Hong Kong have earned recognition as a superb educational exercise, bringing together hundreds of arbitration professionals in a truly international exchange. Arbitrators welcome the chance to see the future leaders of our profession in action. Our talented Mooties have earned their wings through many months of effort, cooperation and dedication. A Mootie's CV attracts attention from recruiters who recognize the Vis experience as the hallmark of a resourceful, diligent and practical team player – that perfect first-year associate who can hit the ground running.

The COVID experience changed the world, engendering dozens of online competitions and pre-moots. These are wonderful ways of spreading knowledge, but the face-to-face experience of the Vis Moot and Vis East is irreplaceable. The Moot's social activities foster the exploration of different cultures and forge transnational friendships that endure for years after the participants leave the competition. The Vis is a life-changing experience.

Since the pandemic, the teams have returned in droves, with several new entrants joining. When we began in 2003 with fourteen teams from half a dozen countries, female oralists were rare. This year, 66% of our oralists are women. Our demographics have evolved as arbitration gains acceptance in Asia and South America. We have teams from 39 jurisdictions with 20% from Mainland China, and 17% from India. Civil law teams outnumber common law teams 107 to 50, with two dual jurisdictions.

The success of the "educational experience in the form of a competition" envisaged by the Vis founders depends on our professionals giving back to the arbitration community for its continued development. As we evolve, our challenge is to provide enough dedicated arbitrators to evaluate and advise teams about their writing and advocacy. We rely on the generosity and dedication of arbitration practitioners to help us ensure the quality of every team's Vis East experience. We encourage professionals from all jurisdictions to join us, but Chinese and Indian arbitrators continue to be seriously underrepresented. To our competing oralists: when you leave Hong Kong, remember how important the Moot tribunals were to your Vis East experience. A few years from now, we want to see you back here as one of them!

We thank our generous sponsors in Hong Kong and abroad who help bring the whole exercise to life. The Chartered Institute of Arbitrators and its East Asia Branch have always been particularly encouraging. To our generous Patrons -- your commitment is so important! The Hong Kong Institute of Arbitrators, CIETAC-HK, and ICC lend their conference rooms for our arguments. Hong Kong's Department of Justice and the Government of Hong Kong, and so many barristers, solicitors and arbitrators come back each year to support. KPMG provides our annual audit. The Moot Alumni Association ("MAA") also plays a huge role in organizing social events during Orals Week continued contacts, and providing bright young scholars with their first opportunity for publication. It does take a village!

Despite the current tragic conflicts around the world, Vis East remains a beacon of hope to young professionals to learn and to live the fair and peaceful resolution of disputes.

All of us from the Vis East Moot Team look forward to meeting you in person and to making your experience a memorable one!




The Vis Moot was the brainchild of three law professors, [Eric Bergsten](#), [Al Kritzer](#) and [Michael Sher](#). Their aim was to encourage the use of UNCITRAL's then brand new Convention on the International Sale of Goods ("CISG"). Established in Vienna the home of UNCITRAL, the Vis was the first private law international moot. It began in 1992-1993 with 9 teams and has expanded to about 400 competing law schools today. To ensure that every Moot participant benefits from an international intercultural experience, there are no national or regional elimination rounds. This year at Vis East there are 31 schools from Mainland China, 22 from India and 15 from Germany, as well as from 36 other jurisdictions.

Because of the international business community's marked preference for arbitration as the means for resolving trans-border commercial disputes, the Vis Moot was created as a clinical tool for training law students in the crucial aspects of the procedure: research, analysis, drafting and advocacy. Student teams read and analyse the facts and evidence of a case, identify the legal issues, seek out the relevant legal texts, craft their legal arguments, draft memoranda for the claimant and respondent, and argue orally on the basis of those memoranda before international tribunals of practicing professionals.

The Vis problem involves the CISG and other commercial law, in the context of an international arbitration. The rules under which the arbitration is conducted change each year. This year the Arbitration Rules of the Singapore International Arbitration Centre (SIAC) govern the procedure.

As cross-border business transactions and international disputes were on the rise in APAC, the Vis East Moot Competition was created by Louise Barrington in 2003 to bring the principles and goals of the Vis Moot to the Asia Pacific region. From the 14 teams who participated in the very first Vis East Moot, in 2003/4, this year's 23rd Vis East Moot welcomes 179 registered teams. It is the leading event in developing knowledge of the CISG in the APAC region and in promoting global cooperation in the field of international commercial arbitration.

In addition to providing a unique and practical experience for law students, the Vis and Vis East Moot provide an opportunity for the practitioners to hone their own CISG skills, and to meet and interact with other professionals from around the world.

Ciarb was founded more than 100 years ago in the United Kingdom with the objective to resolve disputes by alternative means of private dispute resolution. Ciarb has almost 19,000 members at 44 branches in 150 jurisdictions, we are one of the world’s largest community of private dispute resolution professionals.

The Ciarb East Asia Branch (EAB) is the largest branch of the Ciarb. The Ciarb EAB has almost 3,000 members, covering Hong Kong, Macau, Taiwan, Mainland China, Mongolia, South Korea, Japan, Myanmar, Vietnam, the Philippines and Indonesia. We are truly proud of EAB’s diversity and international reach.

The Ciarb EAB provides at least 4 different courses every year to allow people to become qualified at different grades of Ciarb membership according to their experience. These are in-person training courses taught by qualified EAB faculties approved by Ciarb Headquarters. This year, the EAB also collaborates with Ciarb Australia and Ciarb Singapore branches to provide the Asia-Pacific Diploma Course in International Commercial Arbitration, one of the Ciarb signature training courses.

The EAB promotes knowledge sharing in regional legal trends and arbitration developments among members. To align with this objective, EAB hosts monthly seminars where ADR and other means of dispute resolution are addressed by high profile speakers. These seminars are usually held in a hybrid format to allow members outside of Hong Kong to join virtually. Each Chapter (South Korea, Japan, Taiwan) also organises regular seminars at their region.

A distinguished part of EAB is our strong and active Young Members Groups (“YMG”), in both Hong Kong and our Chapters. The YMG is designed for practitioners under the age of 40 who want to explore all things ADR. Today, the EAB YMG has more than 1,200 members and developed various chapters including Taiwan, Indonesia, Japan, South Korea, and the Philippines.

Vis East is an excellent opportunity to meet both students and leading arbitration practitioners from around the world. While your focus remains with the competition, you are encouraged to make as many connections and friends as you can during your stay in Hong Kong. The valuable guidance and experience you receive during Vis East will no doubt help to shape your arbitration career in the future.

Ingeborg Schwenzer is Professor emerita of Private Law at the University of Basel, Switzerland, and former Dean of Swiss International Law School. Additionally, she is an adjunct professor at Bond University, Gold Coast, Australia, and has been an adjunct professor at City University, Hong Kong, and at Griffith University, Brisbane, Australia. She has published numerous books and more than 200 articles in the fields of law of obligations (contracts, tort law and unjust enrichment, sales law both domestic and international), commercial arbitration as well as family law. In particular, she is the co-editor and one of the main contributors of the world's leading Commentary on the Convention on the International Sale of Goods (CISG) (5th edition, Oxford, OUP: 2022) and its German, Spanish, Portuguese, Turkish, and Polish counterparts. From 2011 to 2018 Ingeborg Schwenzer was the chair of the CISG Advisory Council. She is also active in all areas of legal practice. In particular, she regularly acts as arbitrator, counsel and legal expert in international disputes.

The Honourable Madam Justice Mimmie Chan has been the Judge in charge of the Construction and Arbitration List of the High Court since 2 September 2013 and hence needs little introduction to those working in the arbitration community in Hong Kong. The Honourable Madam Justice Mimmie Chan was born in Brunei in 1956. She obtained her Bachelor of Laws from the University of Hong Kong in 1980 and her Postgraduate Certificate in Laws in 1981. She was admitted as a solicitor in Hong Kong in 1983, in England and Wales in 1987, and in Singapore in 1991. She was in private practice from 1983 until she was appointed as District Judge in 2007.
